



AIORI Services Platform Access Terms of Use

1. Introduction

These Terms of Use govern access to and use of the AIORI Platform (the “Service”). By registering for or using the Service, you (the “User”) agree to comply with these Terms. AIORI may update these Terms from time to time; continued use of the Service constitutes acceptance of any changes.

2. Service Description

The AIORI Services Platform provides resources for Internet measurement, research, and education, and other technical services.

3. Eligibility and Registration

Use of the Service requires registration and approval by AIORI. Users must provide accurate and complete information and update it as necessary. AIORI reserves the right to accept or reject registration requests at its sole discretion.

4. User Obligations

Users must use the Service responsibly and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Users must not attempt to interfere with the Service’s operation, security, or other users’ access. Users shall not use the Service to send unsolicited communications or to engage in activities that may harm Internet stability or security.

5. AIORI Rights

AIORI reserves the right to modify, suspend, or discontinue the Service or any part of it without prior notice. AIORI may restrict or terminate a User’s access if they breach these Terms or misuse the Service.

6. Data and Privacy

AIORI processes personal data in accordance with its Privacy Policy. Users consent to the collection and analysis of data generated through their use of the Service, including for research and reporting purposes.

7. Intellectual Property



All intellectual property rights related to the Service remain the property of AIORI or its licensors. Users may not reproduce, modify, or distribute any part of the Service without prior written consent.

8. Certificate Generation

When a user registers for a program, event, course or activity for which a certificate needs to be generated and issued, the user consents sharing the necessary registration data for certificate generation with HNDB. (the Human Network Database), a platform owned and managed by India Internet Foundation. HNDB will be using such data solely for the purpose of generating and issuing such certificate.

9. Limitation of Liability

AIORI provides the Service on an “as is” and “as available” basis. AIORI is not liable for any direct or indirect damages arising from the use or inability to use the Service.

10. Termination

AIORI may terminate a User’s access immediately if they breach these Terms. Users may cease using the Service at any time by notifying AIORI.

11. Governing Law

These Terms are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Kolkata.
